



## RULES OF THE AWARD

### „85 years of the PZK and 90 years of the IARU”

1. Name of the award: „85 of the PZK and 90 years of the IARU”.
2. Aim: commemoration of the 85<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the PZK and of the 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the IARU, popularisation of amateur communication and amateur radio.
3. Organiser: Polish Amateur Radio Union
4. Patronage: Editor’s Office of the „Świat Radio” („World of the Radio”) Magazine, Editor’s Office of the “QTC” Magazine.
5. Duration of the radio action: from 1st January to 30th April 2015.
6. Any band and any mode is acceptable, provided that only 1 QSO on a particular band is valid – regardless of the mode (contacts repeated on another mode and on the same band will not be accepted as valid for granting points).

#### 8. Points.

**SP and EU stations have to collect 85 points.** Contacts valid for the award can be made with the special event stations – listed in the above-mentioned table, and with any other individual or club stations (line no. 13 of the table) – during the specified period. At least **3** QSOs with **xx85PZK** special event stations and at least **3** QSOs with **xx90IARU** special event stations are obligatory, that is to say – 6 QSOs altogether with our special event stations.



**DX stations have to make at least 4 QSOs:**

- **2 QSOs with XX85PZK,**
- **2 QSOs with XX90IARU.**

9. The award is also available for the SWL stations.

**10. Applications for the award.**

The award on the occasion of **the 85th anniversary of establishment of the PZK and of the 90th anniversary of establishment of the IARU** will be issued only in paper version as free of charge and it will be distributed through the QSL bureaus of the IARU Member Societies, or as „DIRECT” – after submission of the „return fee” in form of an envelope containing the payment (**3 USD**), or its equivalent in Polish zloty (PLN).
